SPECIAL / OPERATIONAL PERMIT FEES

Permit fees must be paid when the permit application is submitted.		
PERMIT	SCOPE	PERMIT FEE
Carnivals and Fairs	An operational permit is required to conduct a carnival or fair.	\$100
Fireworks Display	An operational permit is required to conduct a public fireworks display. Plans must be reviewed and a site visit must be conducted. After approval and following the initial site visit, a second site visit must be conducted immediately prior to the event. Records of the event and permitting must be maintained. An onsite marshal or inspector may be required during the event.	\$100
Special Event (Mass Gathering and Special Assignments)	An operational permit is required to conduct a special event. Special events include a mass gathering as defined in the State of Texas Health and Safety Code and other events where a public safety plan is required by the Fire Marshal.	\$200
Tent Permit	Tents and membrane structures having an area in excess of 400 square feet shall not be erected, operated or maintained for any purpose without first obtaining a permit.	\$50
Burn Permit	A burn permit grants the individual holder the right to burn small amounts of dry leaves, plant clippings, and brush.	\$50
