

Does everyone in your home know how to **ESCAPE A FIRE?**

1 **Make and Practice a Home Escape Plan!**

Ensure every room has two ways out. All windows and doors should open easily. Keep all exits clear. Determine a safe meeting place where everyone will meet in case of fire.

Practice your **Exit Drills in the Home (EDITH)** on a regular basis with all household members.

2 **Hear the Beep Where you Sleep!**

Ensure every bedroom has a working smoke alarm.

Test your alarms monthly, and change batteries annually or more often.

Let everyone in your home hear what the alarm sounds like.

3 **Get Low and Go!**

Immediately take action when you smell smoke, see flames, or hear the alarm.

Get low under smoke. Crawl if you need to.

Check the door for heat before opening it. If it's hot, use your 2nd exit.

4 **Get Out and Stay Out!**

Once you are safely outside, never go back inside for anything or anyone.

Go to your safe meeting place, per your family's Home Escape Plan.

Let the firefighters know who is missing, including people and pets.
