# Pflugerville Fire Department

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Internship Program gives individuals direct fire service experience and an inside look at the District. This affords an individual the opportunity to see if a career in the fire service fits their goals. The program traditionally lasts 18 weeks and requires 40 hours per week of classroom and intense hands-on instruction; generally from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. Interns are trained concurrently in fire prevention, suppression, rescue, public fire safety education, emergency medical services, and physical conditioning. Outside the classroom interns will make fire prevention visits, participate in public education, perform other assignments, and may participate in ride-alongs on emergency vehicles.

## QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least **18 years of age**.
- HS Diploma or equivalent.
- Not have any conditions that would disqualify one from eventual employment as a firefighter/EMTs in Texas.
- Must be able to pass background checks.
- Must be eligible to work in the U.S.
- Must be able to read, write and speak English.

- Either **(a)** be a graduate of a District recognized high school program, or **(b)** possess the TCFP certification, or **(c)** possess the EMT - Basic certification, or
- Successfully complete the District basic aptitude exam.

## INTERNSHIP BENEFITS

- Condensed training timeline.
- Tuition free.
- Quarterly Stipend upon completion of each period of training.
- Basic structure fire suppression course, approved by the TCFP.
- Emergency medical training course, approved by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS).
- Conditioning for the Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT).
- Successful completion of Internship Program and passing necessary exams may lead to employment with District or other fire service employers.

## STIPEND

- Stipend of **\$1,000.00** upon completion of each period of training, up to a **maximum of \$4,000.00**

## WRITTEN EXAM & PHYSICAL TEST

- **Written Aptitude Exam:** Designed to evaluate knowledge, skills and/or abilities in the following areas: advising and interacting with others, using logical reasoning to draw valid conclusions, mechanical reasoning, and understanding and interpreting written material pertaining to fire.
- **Physical Strength/Ability Test:** Measure the ability of the individual to perform, in a reasonable manner the duties and responsibly of a Firefighter such as climbing a latter, pulling a fire house, and lifting fire equipment.
