Individual members of the public wishing to submit written comments must submit them by email to info@pflugervillefire.org or calling (512) 251-2801 at least 2 hours in advance of the meeting. Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of 3 minutes on any matter. Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of 30 minutes on any single matter. Individuals may address the Board once per item. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, or comment will be made for items not on this agenda.

PUBLIC COMMENT

1. Call regular meeting to order;
2. Public Comment: *In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda.*

3. Discuss and consider taking action regarding the 2026 tax rate, including:
 - establishing proposed tax rate by taking record vote;
 - scheduling public hearing and meeting to vote to adopt tax rate;
 - authorizing expense and publication of “Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase” or “Notice of Public Meeting on Tax Rate”, whichever is appropriate, in the Pflugerville Pflag; and
 - acknowledging and approving the posting of “Notice About 2026 Tax Rates” and “Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase” or “Notice of Public Meeting on Tax Rate” to the homepage of the District website;
4. Adjourn the meeting.
